Additional procedures include seeking raw material certification through our supply chain, ensuring all regulatory requirements are met, identifying product risks and obtaining 3rd party testing when necessary.

Starline follows our "Starline 3rd Party Testing Policy" to identify products that may require 3rd Party Testing. When it is determined that a product will undergo 3rd party testing Starline will contact a Nationally Recognized Testing Lab or similar. Additionally, we have identified all relevant product standards and regulations and have established voluntary standards.

Starline's products are designed and intended for use by businesses and individuals as general use promotional items, none of our products are intended for children under the age of 12. Starline has reviewed all of our items and determined that they are not to be children's products. Generally, our products are not intended as children's products, if required by imprint or product design Starline will review the product to determine the necessary testing.

Starline has reviewed our product lines and determined they meet all applicable standards and regulations issued under the Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA), the Federal Hazardous Substances Act (FHSA), and the Flammable Fabrics Act (FFA).
